Thankyou for your letter dated 28 September 2012 informing us that you wish to install a 'smartmeter' on our property at a future date.

We are the owners of Title in Fee Simple of the above property and hereby do not give consent to the installation of any microwave emitting 'smartmeter' device on the above property. We are happy with the analogue meter and have no objections to it being read manually.

We are aware that Energy Companies have been instructed by Government legislation to install 'smartmeters' "to the best of their abilities". We are also aware there is no legislation addressed to Consumers, which forces residents to have microwave emitting 'smartmeter' monitoring devices on their properties.

Our main objections to having a 'smartmeter' device attached to our property are as follows:-

1. HEALTH. The Owners of the above property DO NOT, and WILL NOT permit the use of any microwave emitting devices on our property. This is because of high electro-sensitivity of occupants, which can be confirmed by our Health Practitioner. Headaches and nausea which have been experienced by the undersigned when visiting properties where microwave smartmeters were installed, were alleviated on departure from the area.

The WHO has classified microwaves as a Class 2B carcinogen. ARPANSA standards are below overseas standards and the Precautionary Principle has not been employed. There have been no long term studies of microwave 'smartmeter' effects on humans and the environment. This makes the 'smartmeter' grid an untested technology. Children are especially vulnerable, according to many credible scientific studies. Millions of people are being experimented upon without their knowledge or consent in this exponentially expanding microwave grid. This is in violation of the Victorian Charter of Human Rights. ESV, who was given the task of investigating 'smartmeters' safety has completely ignored the health issues.

Many people who have experienced illness after a 'smartmeter' was installed on or nearby their properties, have had extensive disruptions to their lives. This has cost consumers thousands of dollars by forcing them to take protective measures or move their family to another area. They have received no compensation, and this is unjust in a democratic society.

2. PRIVACY. We do not give consent for a surveillance device to be installed upon our property which will measure each and every usage of our electrical equipment. If we want to do so, we can obtain non wireless devices which will do this. We have purchased electrical appliances for our personal use, not for your use, therefore we do not consent to your company, your agents, or any other entity monitoring and storing data from electrical appliances which are used in our home.

- 3. SECURITY. We do not give consent to have any microwave emitting surveillance device on our property which, according to experts can be easily hacked into, data stolen, or malicious data installed. Although you say you comply with the Federal Privacy Act (1998), ESV confidentially rules and National Electricity Rules, you cannot ensure full privacy or protection from malicious intent or intrusion from other entities relating to wireless 'smartmeter' transmission data.
- 4. SAFETY. We do not give consent for a 'smartmeter' device to be installed on our property when there is no Guarantee that it will not cause damage to our property. There have been many meltdowns and fires connected with 'smartmeters' and although the Government says they are safe, you do not give any Guarantees that they will not cause fires or cause equipment to malfunction. Existing wiring and analogue meters rarely overheat to the extent that the increased loading on the wiring by 'smartmeters' will cause. We know of many people who have experienced equipment malfunction and failures after a 'smartmeter' was installed on their property. They have not been reimbursed for the damage caused.
- 5. HIGHER COSTS. The installation of the grid infrastructure is costing more. 'Smartmeters' are costing more. The cost of energy is going up. Consumers cannot save energy when the 'smartmeter' devices use more power to operate. All these higher costs ultimately fall on the Consumers. Then you want to limit Consumer use with Time of Use Tariffs to make the 'smartmeter grid' appear more cost effective. It is evident in all instances, Consumers are being manipulated into using less power when they really need it, and are having to pay higher costs in the long term.

We forbid, refuse and deny consent of any installation and use of any monitoring, eavesdropping, and surveillance devices on our property, our place of residence and our place of occupancy. That applies to and includes microwave 'smartmeters' and activity monitoring devices of any and all kinds. Any attempt to install any such device will constitute trespass, stalking, wiretapping, unlawful surveillance and endangerment to our health and safety. Notice to principal is notice to agent and notice to agent is notice to principal. All rights reserved.
